Parent Right-to-Know (ESSA, Section 1112(e)(1)(A)): At the beginning of each school year, the district notified the parents of each student attending any Title I-A school receiving Title I funds that they may request and the district provided the parents on request (and in a timely manner) information regarding the professional qualifications of their student's classroom teachers.

Timely Notice (ESSA, Section 1112(e)(1)(B)(i)(ii)): A school that receives funds under Title I-A shall provide to each individual parent of a child who is a student in the Title I-Part A school, with respect to the student—

- information on the level of **achievement and academic growth** of the student, if applicable and available, on each of the State academic assessments required under this part; and
- **timely notice** that the student has been assigned, or has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who does not meet applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.

Testing Transparency (ESSA, Section 1112(e)(2)(B)(C):

- At the beginning of each school year, a district that receives Title I-Part A funds notifies the parents of each student attending a Title I-Part A school that the parents may request, and the district provide the parents on request (and in a timely manner), information regarding any State or district policy regarding student participation in any assessments mandated by section 1111(b)(2) and by the State or district, including a policy, procedure, or parental right to opt the child out of the assessment, where applicable.
