**Notes**

States should not expect waiver. They instead offered an addendum waiver. The point is to eliminate risks from missing data from last year.

We will publish a department waiver.

Information on Building Eligibility Flexibilities. Correct enrollment counts has been a challenge for districts. We are going back to the last school year's numbers for funding in regard to title programming. Edits are allowed within the system. Please include your report information to back up the edited data. Please redact student names. We will provide additional guidance on waivers. A flexibility session will be available at OAASFEP conference.

ESSER II Allocations – we will provide documents to assist in developing budgets and completing application. This preparation will allow districts to start their application prior to its release. Equitable services requirements are not within ESSER II. Equitable services will come out of the governor's funding.

US is offering Title IV waiver for 2020/2021 school year/FY20. LEAs would not be required to complete a needs assessment if they received more than \$30,000. Some spending requirements have been waived. No content area spending requirements. 15% limit on tech infra has been waived.
