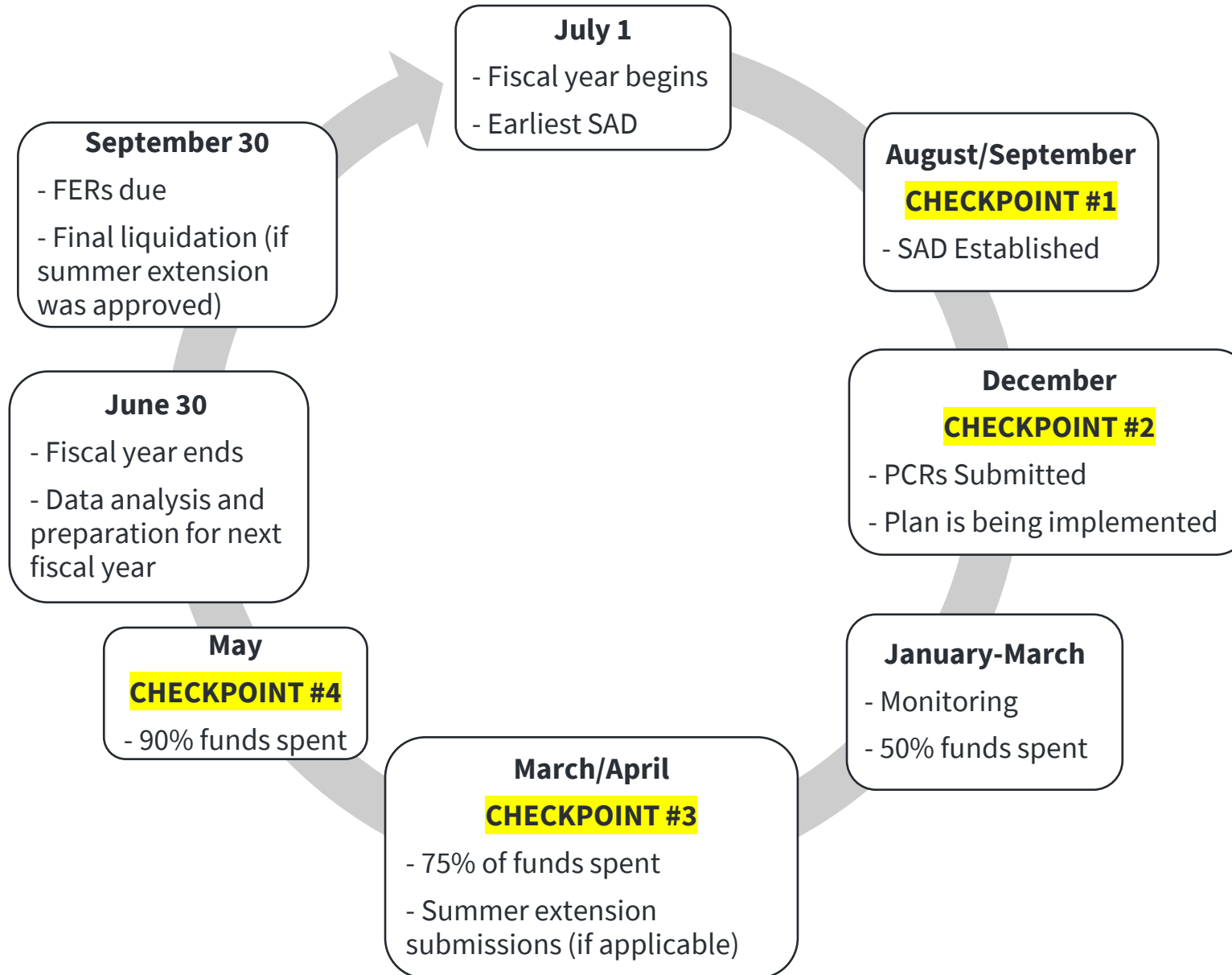

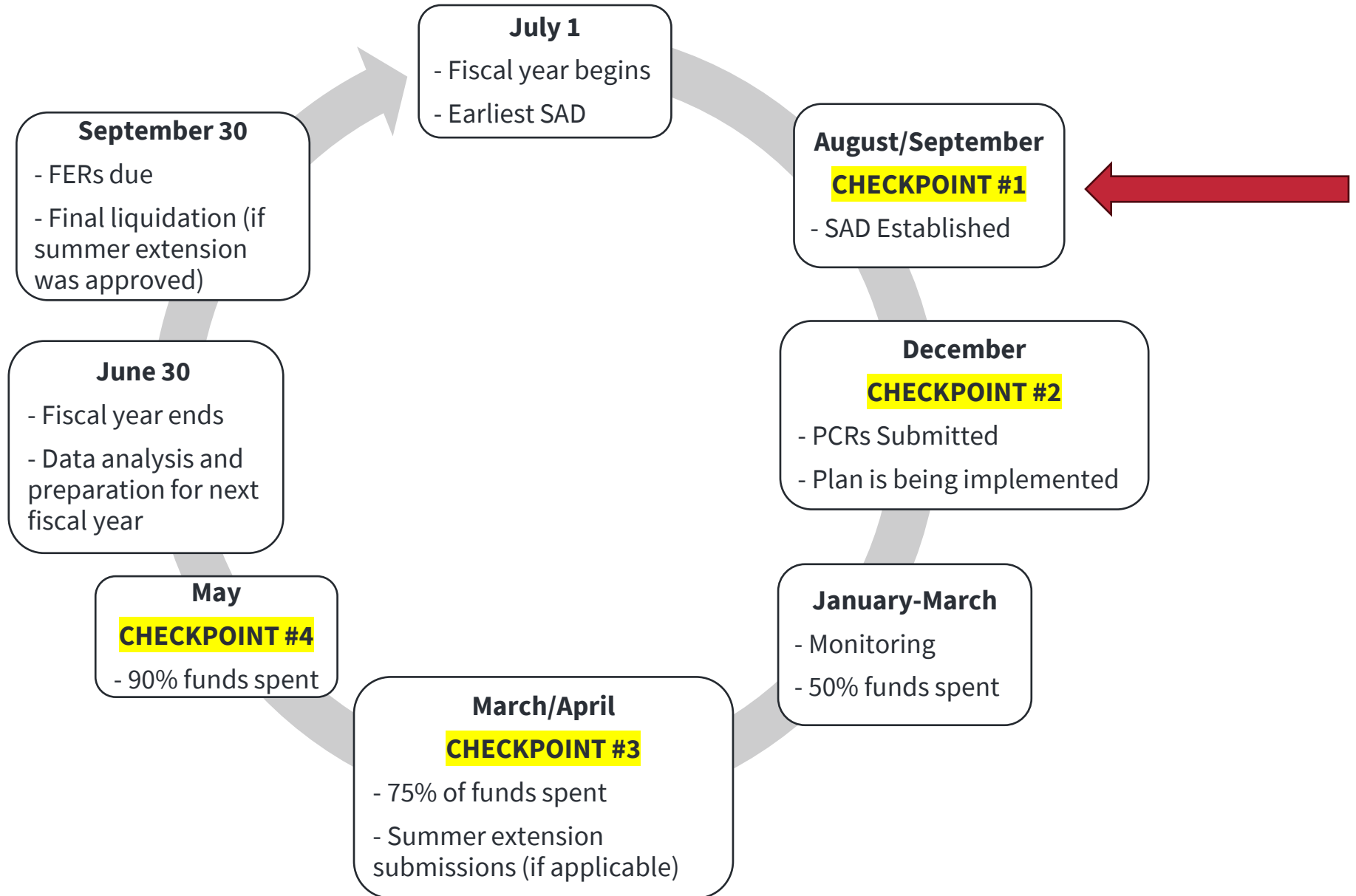
ALIGNMENT TO IDENTIFICATION AND ONE PLAN

- As you create a plan to spend TI NC SSI and EOEC NC funds remember you are required to align planning and spending to the building(s) One Plan.
- In the application you will be asked to provide the Goal title and Strategy title from the LEA's One plan that this funding is tied to.
 - **Example:** LEA One Plan - Goal #1, Strategy #2
- You can revise your One Plan to for better alignment to your grant spending and activities.
- An application cannot be approved if an LEA has not submitted their One Plan.

SUMMER EXTENSION

- We strongly encourage grantees to intentionally and strategically plan for summer activities.
- LEAs will still be required to formally request a summer extension later in the fiscal year.
- LEAs will still be required to submit a written history log note requesting a summer extension once the window opens in Spring 2025. More information will be released as we get closer to this date.

BEST PRACTICES TO KICKOFF THE NEW FISCAL YEAR

- Update and confirm grant contacts in OEDS.
- Allocate funds to identified buildings in the district. Make sure all numbers match between the Budget Grid and the individual building budgets.
- Complete grant application in the CCIP to establish the earliest SAD to begin grant funded programs and initiatives.
- Create an implementation plan for grant funded activities.
- Determine if summer programming expenses should be included in the grant application.
- It is best practice to submit PCRs on a quarterly basis, at least.
